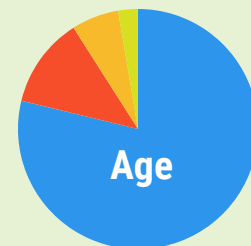

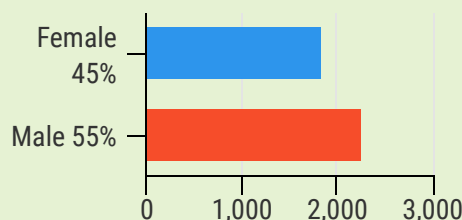

- **2013** opened the Barbara M. Vassel Comprehensive Care Center for children and families
- **2015** expanded services to include alcohol and other drug prevention for youth and family support services

School-Based Programs

Our school-based therapy program continues to grow, expanding into more school districts totaling 11 along with six charter schools. PCS has a bell-to-bell immersion model with therapists and CPST's in partnership.
