They mentioned all sorts of items, from notebooks to help clients journal or better manage time and tasks, to fidget toys to help them cope safely and avoid destructive behaviors, to markers and play-doh for creative outlets when talking isn't enough.

Most Requested Items:

Markers, Tempera Paint, Construction Paper, Fidget Toys (Stress Balls, Squishies, Little Ouchies, etc.), Notebooks (big or small), Noise Cancelling Headphones, Slime, Play-Doh, and Hygiene Items
